## Yahoo! Bears

I've been a member of the Heart of Texas Bears for a couple of years. I consider myself fortunate to have gotten to know a lot of you already, and I can truly say that the overwhelming positive attitude of the club's membership is what keeps bringing me back. (Plus, we always seem to have a lot of fun!) We had a blast in 2004, and added a major new event to our calendar, in the HOT Bear "UnRun", and I'm excited to hear about other new events this year, like the Bears in the Woods TCC Landsite Run.

I have always thought that the Heart of Texas Bears needed a mailing list, or a web-forum, for members to interact and share ideas "off the calendar," or informally. I know a lot of the time, I just need to get out of the house, and there is always something cool to do in Austin. Even slacker bears like me can get out at nearly the last minute and go hear some live music, or catch a movie or a play. I thought a e-mail list would help find likeminded men to hang out with. A team was formed to explore the options and work with the Executive Committee (your officers of the club) to set something like this up. This team decided to setup a "Yahoo! Group," and opened it to a testing by a limited number — everyone who came to the January Quarterly Meeting, namely.

Well, our testing period is over, and e-mails and invitations have gone out to the entire membership now. Last time I checked we have 44 members, and 41 messages posted so far this month,

which is great! There has been a lot of interaction already, but I would love to see more. We should be able to double the number of members to the new Group — all it would take to do this is everyone we've already invited to sign up! So consider this a gentle reminder...

You'll need to sign in with a Yahoo! ID, then point your web browser to http://groups.yahoo.com/groups/ HOTBears and click on the Join Now button. Easy as that! You can set your account to receive every e-mail as they are posted to the group's e-mail address, you can receive a daily digest of all the posted e-mails, or you can also set your preferences to receive only the Special Notices from the group's moderators and read your fellow member's messages on the website. The HOT Bears Yahoo! Group website also has features to share photos so we can put names with faces, a real-time chat room, and other webbased features, like polls, etc.

Saturday morning, wake up to soft music and enjoy a continental breakfast in the dinning area. The scavenger hunt starts at 10am and goes until 7pm. Friendly competition games with prizes happen all day long for those who want to join in — or you can splash in the pool with your fellow bears. Of course, there will be cocktail parties all day long, along with a good lunch. For those who want a little alone time, a hike in the woods is always enjoyable, and you never know what kind of nature you

will encounter.

Saturday evening, there will be a big dinner, cooked up by Shannon (Mr. HOT Bear) followed by a show hosted by John Cowart (our MC at the UnRun last year). Afterwards, more cocktail parties and further fellowship around the campground.
